Chris, The locations you list would in general be helpful, but I suggest the list needs refinement and additions, but no deletions.

1. I assume your no. 4 refers to the upper Waimakariri. Simulations to show the works proposed from the intake through to the tunnel are needed. A Rubicon Road view is not expected to be adequate. River views as well as aerial perspectives are also suggested.
2. From the Rakaia intake, the canal from the river traversing the three terraces needs to be shown, and on up across Steeles Road through to Rakaia Terrace Road. Views from below and from the terraces are needed.
3. For the Selwyn River crossing, the effects on both sides of the river need to be shown, from north of the River to Plantation Road.
4. By the toe of the Harper Hills, the view of the dam and canal from the first uphill section of the Coalgate Walkway.
5. For Coaltrack Road there is a need for several views. From Coalgate looking along the canal length in the east through to the south and across to Hororata Road. Approaching Coalgate from the east of the proposed canal. Also, from close to the canal on the west side as it crosses Coaltrack Road the view along the canal to the Selwyn crossing and the Harper Hills.
7. There is also a need for simulations of the canal zig-zagging across the lower slope of the Harper Hills, between Plantation Road and the Hororata River and Rockwood Road.
8. Simulations are also needed of the proposed canal wrapping around to the east and south as potentially experienced from Coalgate village, including from the Reserve.
