

Details of still affected MHPS Members - CPW Hearing 11 May '09

Madeleine de Jong - No Notice of Requirement on her property but the headrace runs beside her private hotel. MHPS lay submitter .

Gillie and Tim Deans – Affected by NOR. The headrace comes through their farm at Homebush – MHPS lay submitters.

Philip and Jocelyn Deans - They have land in the Waianiwaniwa Valley and want the NOR's withdrawn if dam/reservoir consents are rejected. They also have a part of their farm along Deans Road, Homebush affected by the Headrace canal. They presented evidence to the Hearing on their own behalf.

Louise Deans – Concerned about the Headrace canal crossing Homebush Farm. Will the headrace be moved from their property if the dam/reservoir does not proceed? Will the cutting on their property still be required for a modified scheme? She requests the whole scheme be rejected. MHPS lay submitter.

Cindy MacKenzie - Owns a ^{2ha} block on Cullens Road which is affected by a NOR. Wants to sell her block but has been unable to sell for 4 years. Appeared at the CPW Hearing at Darfield following Brian Deans's presentation.

John and Rosalie Austin- Has two properties affected by the headrace, Bennelong Park on the Downs Road, Hororata, and another farm located near the Hororata township. The Headrace canal will traverse the whole length of their farm property at the Hororata township. Appeared at the CPW Hearing at Darfield on their own behalf.

Nicholas and Ruth Owers – Their land in Hororata is affected by the Headrace canal. They wrote an opposing submission. Their names were included in the list of 84 members who were represented by the MHPS submission.

Heather Thompson and Geoff Fowlds - Their land is affected by a wash canal that traverses their property at Halkett on the banks of the Waimakariri River. They made an opposing submission and were listed among the 84 MHPS members represented by the Society.
