**SUBJECT :** ADDENDUM TO DECISION - CENTRAL PLAINS WATER TRUST

The decision on the resource consent applications was issued on 31 May 2010.

Subsequent to this, it has been ascertained that there are a number of minor errors in the decision, the great majority of which relate to formatting, minor inconsistencies, and clarification of cross-references

Section 133A Resource Management Act enables a consent authority to issue an amended consent to correct such matters.

The corrections apply to parts 9 and 10 of the decision relating to the conditions on both the Canterbury Regional Council and Selwyn District Council.

The amendments are attached to this memorandum and shown as track changes.

A further addendum to the attached amendments is to correct the expiry date for resource consent applications CRC021091, CRC061940 and CRC061980. The decision granted these three applications with 35 year durations when the intention (as recorded in Paragraph 2.118 of Part 6 ) was for an expiry date to be consistent with the expiry date for Ashburton Community Water Trust resource consents of 28 January 2035.


