INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this report is to introduce the vision and objectives for the Canterbury Regional Land Transport Strategy (RLTS) 2011 – 2041.

The vision and objectives of the RLTS should be consistent with legislation and government policy. The objectives describe what the region will focus on to achieve the vision in a broad sense and provide an opportunity to address the key issues and challenges of the RLTS. Many of the objectives are closely linked and interrelated. For example, improving levels of accessibility has the potential to assist economic development. As the RLTS is developed further, the objectives will be used to assess and refine a range of strategic options. This process will lead to the identification of a preferred option that will form the basis of the RLTS.
