I wish to inform you that the Summary of Decisions Requested by persons making original submissions on Variation 2 Chapter 5: Water quantity, Schedule WQN9 and related amendments is now available for inspection and further submissions may now be made. The period for making further submissions commences on **Saturday, 29 April 2006** and closes at **5pm, Monday 29 May 2006**.

Any person can make a further submission in the prescribed form, in support of, or in opposition to, an original submission received on Variation 2. **Only hard copies of further submissions will be accepted and must be addressed to Environment Canterbury at the address for service stated in the attached public notice.**

A Further Submission form is included with the Summary of Decisions Requested. Further Submission forms can also be obtained from the offices of Environment Canterbury at 58 Kilmore Street, Christchurch; 75 Church Street, Timaru; and Beach Road, Kaikoura.
