PROPOSED VARIATION 5 TO THE CANTERBURY NATURAL RESOURCES REGIONAL PLAN

Notice of decisions on submissions and further submissions

In accordance with Schedule 1 of the Resource Management Act 1991, the Canterbury Regional Council gives public notice that it has made decisions on submissions and further submissions on proposed Variation 5 to the Canterbury Natural Resources Regional Plan.

Proposed Variation 5 is deemed to have been amended in accordance with these decisions from the date of this public notice.

Copies of the decisions and this public notice have been served on every person who made a submission or further submission on Variation 5.

People who made a submission on Variation 5 have the right to appeal decisions on their submissions to the High Court, but only on points of law. An appeal must be lodged with the High Court within 15 working days of the date of notification. The 15 day period ends on the 16 November 2010.

All submitters will be sent a copy of the decision.
