What is the appeal process?

As a result of the introduction of the Environment Canterbury (Temporary Commissioners and Improved Water Management) Act 2010, there is no longer a right of appeal to the Environment Court. Instead submitters may only appeal on points of law to the High Court. Attached for the assistance of submitters is guidance as to what might constitute a point of law. Any submitter considering lodging an appeal is encouraged to seek their own legal advice.

For the purposes of determining when the 15 working days end, the public holidays for Labour Day (25 October) and Canterbury Anniversary Day (12 November) are not counted as working days.
