

# PUBLIC NOTICE

## PROPOSED VARIATIONS 1, 2, 4, AND 14 TO THE CANTERBURY NATURAL RESOURCES REGIONAL PLAN

### Notice of decisions on submissions and further submissions

In accordance with Schedule 1 of the Resource Management Act 1991, the Canterbury Regional Council gives public notice that it has made decisions on submissions and further submissions on proposed Variations 1, 2, 4, and 14 to the Canterbury Natural Resources Regional Plan.

Proposed Variations 1, 2, 4, and 14 are deemed to have amended Chapters 4 – 8 of the Canterbury Natural Resources Regional Plan in accordance with these decisions, from the date of this public notice.

Any person who made a submission on one or more of these variations has the right to appeal decisions on their submissions to the High Court, but only on points of law. Each submitter must lodge their appeal with the High Court in Christchurch within 15 working days of receiving notification of the decisions.

Copies of the decisions and this public notice have been served on every person who made a submission or further submission on these variations.

All submitters have been sent a copy of the decisions in an electronic format. Paper copies of decisions can be purchased from Customer Services, and additional electronic copies of the decision can be downloaded from the Council's website [www.ecan.govt.nz](http://www.ecan.govt.nz)
