<p>Name of holder: Richard Milsom on behalf of McConnell Dowell Ltd</p>	
<p>Period: From: 0001 on 15th October 2016 until 2359 on 31st December 2017; or Until revoked by the Harbourmaster.</p>	
<p>Reserved Area: All that area of Gollans Bay from Battery Point to the eastern part of the headland between Gollans Bay and Livingstone Bay as indicated on the attached chartlet and delineated from time to time by marker buoys.</p>

<p>Purpose: Blasting of the Summit Road over-looking Gollans Bay, associated with the rock deconstruction works for road reinstatement requires exclusion of all vessels from Gollans Bay except as expressly permitted.</p>	
<p>Reservation: No vessel shall navigate within the Reserved Area as listed above except with the express permission of, and in a manner explicitly approved by, the certificate holder or his delegate.</p>

<p>A copy of the Temporary Reservation Certificate to be carried by: The safety patrol vessel.</p>	
<p>Safety conditions: As per submitted safety plan, including, but not limited to: A safety patrol vessel that is in direct contact with the blasting supervisor shall be stationed outside the Reserved Area prior to and during blasting to ensure the area is clear of all vessels before any each blast is undertaken. Buoys shall be placed outside, but within 200m of, the line indicated on the attached chartlet in order to indicate the Reserved Area to vessels.</p>	
<p>Temporary Reservation shall not take effect if: Conditions above are not met.</p>
