

**Temporary Reservation Certificate, issued pursuant to:

Purpose: To grant access by a power craft (IRB) in the Corsair Bay area reserved for non-powered craft and swimming only for safety purposes only prior to and during the KPMG Real Swim Race Series
Reservation: Allow nominated power craft (IRBs) to operate within the reserved area, and to transit to and from the beach.
Conditions:
Publication of notice of Reservation: Notification to known affected groups; notifications on appropriate websites and social media; notices at known boat ramps and key access points.
Notice of Reservation to be: Displayed at: Corsair bay entrance to public walkway Displayed by: Daniel Able(or delegate). Removed by: Daniel Able (or delegate); or the Harbourmaster
A copy of the Temporary Reservation Certificate to be carried by: Nominated Event Controller
Safety conditions: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The exemption applies only on the days of the KPMG Real Swim Series races between the hours of 4pm and 9 pm. 2. The exemption applies for a maximum of two safety IRBs per event. 3. The vessel is to be an approved rescue boat such as used by Surf-Life saving New Zealand which is an IRB with a propeller guard. 4. The vessels used are to be manned by two crew members, both whom must hold current rescue crew certificates. 5. The vessel is to operate at a speed less than 5 knots whilst in Corsair Bay except in case of emergency. 6. This exemption allows the nominated vessels to operate within the reserved area, and to transit to and from the beach.

Temporary Reservation shall not take effect if: Conditions above are not met.
