Scroll to the bottom of the search box and click 'Download Summary Report' for more detailed information about a mooring:



The Mooring Summary report shows the details about this particular mooring:

- Location
- Inspection dates
- Maximum boat size authorised for the mooring
- Mooring specifications the mooring should meet
- Vessels that have been associated with the mooring
- Current mooring system configuration and wear on components (as reported in the inspection)
- Last block inspection
- Information on the block.
