

Name of holder: <b>Jet Boating New Zealand Incorporated (JBNZ)</b>	
Period: <b>12 JBNZ club events during the period from 01<sup>st</sup> February until 31<sup>st</sup> May, inclusive, of each year. Commencing 2017 until the Bylaw has completed its next review; or until revoked by the Harbourmaster.</b>	
Reserved Area: <b>The Ahuriri river from Lake Benmore up to Ireland Road Bridge (as indicated on the attached map).</b>	
Map attached: <b>Yes/No</b>	
Purpose: <b>To declare a temporary Speed Uplifted Zone (SUZ) to allow navigation of the Ahuriri River by power-driven vessels operated by members of JBNZ, during club events only, at times and flows that mitigate to acceptable levels any navigation safety issues between them and other known user groups.</b>	
Reservation: <b>The Reserved Area as listed above is declared by the Harbourmaster to temporarily be a SUZ for the stated period only. No power-driven vessel shall navigate within the Reserved Area except that the vessel is under the command of a full member of JBNZ; and is properly marked in accordance with the Bylaw; and with the permission of, and in a manner approved by, the certificate holder; and in accordance with the terms and conditions stated on this certificate.</b>	
Conditions:	
Publication of notice of Reservation: <b>Notifications to known affected groups; notifications on appropriate websites and social media.</b>	
Flow limits: <b>The SUZ shall only apply at flows of 20 cumecs or greater (as reported by the Environment Canterbury Ahuriri River flow recorder at SH8).</b>	
Notice of Reservation to be: Displayed at: <b>As above.</b>	
A copy of the Temporary Reservation Certificate to be carried by: <b>The JBNZ club event leader's vessel on the day of each event.</b>	
Safety conditions: <b>Every vessel operating under this Temporary Reservation shall do so in compliance with the Bylaw; and all relevant Maritime Rules; and all relevant rules and codes of practice of JBNZ.</b>	
Temporary Reservation shall not take effect if: <b>Conditions above are not met.</b>
