Purpose: To allow a power-driven vessel on the Tekapo River upstream of the weir below Lake George Scott by: Exemption from the requirements of the Navigation Safety Bylaw 2016 Controls Attachment A clause B(4)(a) and Maps 28 & 29; and uplifting the speed limit of 5 knots within 200m of shore imposed by Maritime Rules Part 91.6(1)(b).
Reservation: The holder of this Temporary Reservation is permitted to: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Navigate a power-driven on the Tekapo River upstream of the weir below lake George Scott; and Exceed the speed limit of 5 knots within 200m of shore.

A copy of the Temporary Reservation Certificate to be carried by: The holder when exercising this Temporary Reservation.
Safety conditions: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> This Temporary Reservation is for private vessels driven by Mark Morgan only. The holder of this reservation is responsible for assessing the safety risk including river flow prior to launching. The 5 knot speed limit is to be adhered to if there are other vessels or persons in the water within 50 metres. The vessel must not approach within 200m of any Genesis Energy dam, intake or weir. The vessel must not enter any part of the Tekapo Whitewater Course at any time and must not approach within 50m of the course intake gates, nor navigate during any scheduled recreational release. Genesis Energy, Whitewater New Zealand and the Tekapo White Water Trust are to be advised (as per their requirements) in advance of the commencement of any journey and subsequent closure of that trip.
Temporary Reservation shall not take or have effect if: Conditions above are not met.
