### <u>Irrigation – All systems</u>

The minimum level of practice for irrigation management in Hinds/Hekeao Plains area includes lower application rates in the shoulders of the irrigation season (Sept/Oct and March/April) than in the peak of the irrigation season.

An exception to the shoulder period differential will apply if the system has limited system capacity during peak demand, and therefore runs to the maximum capacity through shoulder periods and peak demand times.

### Nitrogen (Fertiliser and Effluent Management) - Pastoral Systems

The minimum level of practice for nitrogen anticipates

- a. Nitrogen fertiliser is not applied in the months of May, June or July.
- b. Nitrogen is not applied in excess of 450kg/ha/yr (cumulative total of nitrogen from fertiliser and effluent). This is at a block level rather than property level.

Farms with practices better than the minimum level of practice should not adjusted their Nitrogen Baseline files unless their irrigation was based on soil moisture monitoring. This is considered beyond good practice in Hinds/Hikeao Plains area. Farms utilising soil moisture monitoring during the baseline period can choose to model irrigation practice as if fixed return periods were used, modified on the shoulders of the season.
