- 2. All competitors are to be advised that whilst the area notified in this Temporary Reservation Certification have been uplifted and reserved for the sole purpose of the Canterbury Jet Sports Club jet ski race, should an unauthorised vessel or other water user be on the course, all vessels are immediately to comply with Maritime Transport Act 1994 Rules 91 and 22.
- 3. All competitors must be at least 600m from the water's edge always when racing between Spencer Park and Scarborough: refer appendix 2


## **Appendix 1: Map of course opposite Spencer Park Surf Club**
