- No other vessel shall navigate within the Reserved Area as delineated on the maps attached, except vessels under the command of a full member of JBNZ; and are properly marked in accordance with the Bylaw; and with the permission of, and in a manner approved by, the certificate holder; and in accordance with the terms and conditions stated on this certificate.

Notification to known affected groups; notifications on appropriate websites and social media; notices at known boat ramps and key access points. At least 14 days prior to the race day.

- 1. Every vessel operating under this Temporary Reservation shall do so in compliance with the Bylaw; and all relevant Maritime Rules; and all relevant rules and codes of practice of JBNZ.
- 2. Every Vessel operating under this Temporary Reservation shall be made aware of the JBNZ Safety SOPs in relation to river racing and follow then accordingly.
- 3. All competitors are to be advised that whilst the rivers notified in this Temporary Reservation Certificate have been uplifted and reserved for the sole purpose of the races specified, should an unauthorised vessel be on the
