A safety officer/event manager is to be appointed and will take control should any on water incident occur.3. It is the responsibility of the safety officer/event manager to ensure the course is clear of non-participating vessels or fishermen prior to the event starting.4. Should any unauthorised vessel or fisherman enter the course, this reservation is revoked until the course is clear, and Maritime Rule 22 and 91, Navigation safety Bylaw 2016 will apply.5. NZ Coastguard SOPs to be complied with.
