SCHEDULE C

Species Suitable for Shelterbelt Planting, McLeans Island

Shelter plantings are restricted to local native species to ensure plantings are compatible with the ecology of the adjoining native grassland park and cause minimal detrimental effects on its grassland/shrubland ecosystem. the plants are grouped according to soil conditions. Primary Shelter Species are those most likely to provide a shelter function. Species of ecological value are included for information of adjoining owners who wish to plant other appropriate species to enhance the ecological values of the area. These plants are either slow growing or of small size and thus provide less shelter value.

All plantings shall be of local sourced plants to avoid modification of the generic makeup of local species through hybridisation with native plants in the adjoining reserve.

Planting success will be greater with rabbit browse protection, mulching and readily available water.


