## **MAY IT PLEASE THE CHAIRPERSON**

- 1 The evidence from Mr Hedley, which contains the statutory planning assessment, notes the significant changes to the conditions of consent proposed in each of the Officer Reports.<sup>1</sup>
- 2 Mr Hedley notes that while the majority are simply restructuring amendments, there are many substantive changes to the draft conditions of consent proposed by SOL.
