Option Two - \$240M of work

- Statutory requirements
- Freshwater and coastal plans and regional policy statement (RPS)revised
- Some public transport enhancements
- Covid 19 resilience projects
- Wilding pine and wallaby control



Option One = Option Two + \$6M

- Enviroschools and wider environmental education
- Further public transport improvement
- More land owner support and compliance staff
- Enhanced regeneration of native forests (Me Uru Rākau)
- More data collection Mātauranga Māori and citizen science
- Contestable community fund (\$450k total for 3 yrs)
- Additional Braided river action


