Avon River, in vicinity of Medway Street, 100m upstream and downstream of bridge works.

Purpose:

Exclusion of all unauthorised vessels within safety zone of 100m either side of worksite during critical works to allow safe bridge construction.

Reservation:

No vessel shall navigate within the Reserved Area as listed above except with the express permission of, and in a manner explicitly approved by, the certificate holder or his delegate.

Conditions:

Publication of notice of Reservation:

Public notification of exclusion zone as per CCC plan.

Direct notification to rowing and kayak organisations at Kerrs Reach

Notice of Reservation to be:

Displayed on: Appropriate Site Notice Board visible to public

Displayed by: Ryan Hickey (or delegate).

Removed by: Ryan Hickey (or delegate); or the Harbourmaster

A copy of the Temporary Reservation Certificate to be carried by: Site Supervisor and spotters

Safety conditions:

- 1. A section of the river is to be kept clear for safe navigation of paddle craft when critical operations are not undertaken. When this is not possible, a safe landing and walk around must be provided.
- 2. Safety signage to be placed upstream and downstream of the reserved area clearly visible from the water.
- 3. Spotters to be placed either side of reserved area when river is closed.

Temporary Reservation shall not take effect if: **Conditions above are not met.**
