1) This Reservation is made solely to limit others being made in the area. Further details will be notified at a later date.

2) The SailGP event will involve an access limited area/exclusion zone during official training and race days (17-19 March 2023). This expected to extend approximately 0.5NM from the shore between Sticking Point and the Naval Point breakwater. This is subject to a separate process and will be notified at a later date.

Purpose:

Disallowing any other reservations than that which may be required to provide limitations on vessel access for the purpose of running the SailGP event. With the exception of Naval Point Sailing Club's regular Saturday and Wednesday evening races - SailGP shall consult with Naval Point Sailing Club.
