## Canterbury Regional Council submission to the Fisheries New Zealand

- The Canterbury Regional Council ('Environment Canterbury', 'the Council') supports the
  application of Te Hapū o Ngāti Wheke for an extension of the Lyttelton Harbour/Whakaraupō
  Mātaitai Reserve, as outlined in the public notice issued by Fisheries New Zealand Tini a
  Tangaroa.
- 2. Environment Canterbury has an active relationship with the 10 Ngāi Tahu Papatipu Rūnanga within its region. This relationship is referred to as Tuia and is integral to our responsibilities and functions and how we operate in our region. Te Hapū o Ngāti Wheke, the applicants of the Mātaitai extension, are one of our Papatipu Rūnanga partners.
- 3. Of particular relevance to this submission is our work partnering with Ngāti Wheke in the development and implementation of the Whakaora Healthy Harbour plan. Environment Canterbury is one of five partners in this important mahi. The catchment management plan has a vision of restoring the ecological and cultural health of Whakaraupō/Lyttelton Harbour as a mahinga kai, for generations to come. The plan targets six ecological areas for change, including the Whakaraupō Harbour.
- 4. The extension of the mātaitai is complementary to the Whaka-Ora Healthy Harbours vision. As so eloquently described in the application, Whakaraupō is of great significance to Ngāti Wheke as a customary food gathering area.
- 5. Environment Canterbury thereby supports Ngāti Wheke as mana whenua and kaitiaki of Whakaraupō/Lyttelton Harbour in their application to extend the current Mātaitai area.
