# Reserved Areas:

All those areas of the mid-harbour of Whakaraupō / Lyttelton Harbour as indicated on the attached chartlet and described below:

- 1) Event Area All the area of Whakaraupō / Lyttelton Harbour extending generally northwards from the northerly boundary of the Access Lane to the opposite shore including all of the Inner Harbour and the area generally eastward of a line running from Erskine Point breakwater to and through the rear leads and then to the east cardinal mark at the eastern end of Kamautaurua ("Shag Reef").
- 2) Pipe and Cable Zone All the area of Whakaraupō / Lyttelton Harbour with charted seabed cables running between the northern and southern shores of Whakaraupō / Lyttelton Harbour with the eastern extent of the Zone being a line running between points 30 metres eastward of the landward ends of the easternmost seabed pipeline and with the westward extent of the zone being a line parallel to the eastward line but running through the east cardinal mark at the eastern end of Kamautaurua ("Shag Reef").
- 3) Access Lane All the area of Whakaraupō / Lyttelton Harbour extending 200 metres generally northwards of a line running from Pāua-o-Hinekotau / Pauaohinekatau Head to Te Upoko-o-Kurī / Stoddart Point and extending out 1000 metres westward and 500 metres eastward of that line.

# **Purposes:**

- 1) To allow safe set up and operation of the SailGP event; and
- 2) To limit the speed of vessels within the Reserved Areas for safety purposes; and
- 3) To mitigate the safety risks to vessels of potential entanglement with seabed infrastructure; and
- 4) To ensure a clear Access Lane is available to the south of the Event Area for vessels transiting past the Event Area.

- a. No vessel shall navigate within the Event Area except with the express permission of, and in a manner explicitly approved by, the certificate holder or their delegate or the Harbourmaster or any person authorised to assist the Harbourmaster;
- b. Except for those vessels authorised by the Harbourmaster no vessel shall exceed a ground speed of 5 knots within the Event Area.
- c. Only power-driven vessels may enter the Event Area.
- d. No sails may be hoisted within the Event Area.
- 2) Pipe and Cable Zone Except where expressly permitted by the Harbourmaster no vessel nor any structure nor any buoy shall be anchored or secured to the seabed within 30 metres of any cable or pipeline within the indicated Pipe and Cable Zone. For the sake of clarity, this Reservation neither grants nor implies any permission to anchor in way of any cable outside the Pipe and Cable Zone.
- 3) Access Lane
  - a. Except where otherwise expressly authorised by the Harbourmaster no vessel shall anchor or remain within the Access Lane;
  - b. Except for those vessels authorised by the Harbourmaster no vessel shall exceed a ground speed of 5 knots within the Access Lane.

### Publication of notice of Reservation:

Publication of notice of Reservation shall include at least, but not be limited to, the following:

- 1) Notification to known affected groups; and
- 2) Notifications on appropriate websites and social media; and
- 3) Notices at known boat ramps and key access points identified as likely to be used by people wishing to access the areas. Each of these notices shall include a clear and complete copy of this Reservation and shall be posted not later than 1200 hours Friday 03<sup>rd</sup> March 2023 and shall be checked and maintained by the holder to ensure ongoing notification.


