- 1 The purpose of this Minute is to make some minor changes to our pre-existing timetable dated 23 December 2023. These changes respond to a request by submitters for additional time, due to a difficulty with accessing the Council website for information, just prior to the Easter break. This request was communicated by email sent to Council on 02 April 2024. It followed an earlier amendment to the timetable, made at the request of the Applicant.<sup>1</sup>

**2 Our amended directions are as follows:**

- (c) Any final comments in reply by the Applicant are to be filed by 29 April 2024.<sup>4</sup>
