Formal safety briefing to be given to competitors prior to race commencing.3. Course to be surveyed for hazards prior to the start of the race.4. All races to be run under NZPBA safety criteria5. Safety plan supplied to be adhered to.6. Any incidents, accidents or near misses to be reported to the Harbourmaster within 48hrs.7. All competitors and support vessel crews are to wear appropriate PFD's at all times on the water.
